With small caseloads (10-14) The Children's Place structures its program to help children and staff thrive. This is a fulltime, year-round position, children are on site from 8:30-1, Mondays through Fridays, afternoons are for teamwork, meetings and documentation.

On an average day, you will...

- Make appropriate referrals to community agencies on behalf of family served.
- Make regular contact with all Day Treatment families in order to build rapport and assess ongoing needs.
- Work within a multi-disciplinary team to provide strategies, interventions and support to classroom teachers, speech/language pathologist and occupational therapist. This may include support within the classroom environment as needed.
- Create connections with community resources in order to simplify the referral process for families, such as: food pantry, emergency utility assistance, clothing/diapers/hygiene, early childhood special education, etc.
- Maintain a caseload to provide billable client services comprised of case management, and therapy
- Demonstrate compliance with all agency and professional organization policies and procedures.
- Provide oversight of staff member schedules, caseloads, and referrals to program.
